STAY THE COURT'S RULING GRANTING THE FINANCE
COMMITTEE'S MOTION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO MAKE
SECOND PRIORITY PAYMENTS PENDING APPEAL**

For the reasons set forth in the attached brief in support, Dow Corning Corporation and the Debtor's Representatives (hereinafter "Movants") respectfully move this Court pursuant to Fed. R. Civ.
