STIPULATED ORDER UPDATING ORDER GOVERNING CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA PROVIDED TO THE PARTIES

On July 16, 2014, this Court entered the Order Governing Confidentiality of Data Provided to the Parties (ECF No. 979). The purpose of that Confidentiality Order was to specify the terms under which an outside expert retained by Dow Corning Corporation (now Dow Silicones) could obtain redacted claim data for purposes of preparing an analysis for the company's financial reporting obligations.

Dow Silicones has advised the Court of the following:

It must undertake the same tasks this year and, therefore, needs to obtain the updated claims data. Under the applicable guidelines, the outside expert for the company needs to obtain the data during July 2019. The Settlement Facility-Dow Corning Trust (SF-DCT) has advised that it can provide the data in that time frame without disrupting its normal processing functions. The outside expert has advised that in order to structure its models and systems it needs to obtain a current version of the data so that when the post deadline data is provided in July 2019, the outside expert will be able to conduct its analysis within the necessary time frame. The SF-DCT has advised that it could provide an appropriately redacted set of data in May 2019. (The

timeline set by the SF-DCT reflects its determination of how and when it can provide data without disrupting the normal functions of the SF-DCT.)

The Parties agree to the provision of claim data as set forth in this Order. The SF-DCT will provide the same data sets to the Claimants' Advisory Committee.

Accordingly,

The SF-DCT is authorized to provide two sets of claims data to the Parties as outlined above subject to all the same terms and conditions set forth in the Confidentiality Order which is appended hereto and incorporated into this Order.
