I have reviewed a copy of the Order to Show Cause sent by this Court to Kevin McLean. I dispute the allegations made against Mr. McLean.

Kevin M4Lean represented me for over 15 years prior to my settlement with the Dow Claims Office.

I have had numerous conversations with Mr. McLean, paralegals, and other staff members in his San Francisco office, regarding my claim. I have met with Mr. McLean on several occasions to discuss my case. I have always been able to reach him on his 800 number for implant clients. Throughout the years, he had my permission to sign my name to forms and checks.

Mr. McLean spoke with me about my settlement and explained the costs in my case to me. I have had conversations with the settlement office and Mr. McLean and was aware of the costs permissible with this agreement. I know that we received three (3) separate checks, and spoke with Mr. McLean before he deposited those drafts, pursuant to my permission, in fact, the most recent check was lost in the mall in the fall of 2007 and Mr. McLean worked with me and the claims office to have that check re-issued. I know that Mr. McLean was in contact with the claims office in the summer and fall of 2007 as it concerned my case. I know that the compromise I reached with him on my costs was both fair and acceptable to me. I have no complaints against the way my claim was handled by Mr. McLean.
