	2.	On June 14,	2004, the SF-DC	T maile	ed Ms.	a Notification of	
Statu	s (NOS	S) letter on he	er disease claim.

comprising the disease portion (ACTD) of the claim were approved but no

compensation (disability) level was approved. The NOS letter also stated that the deadline to cure the deficiency in her claim is June 14, 2005.

- 4. On May 13, 2005, in an effort to cure the deficiency in Ms. 's disease claim, her counsel submitted a Supplemental Disease Review Form (SDRF) with additional medical records attached, requesting that the SF-DCT rereview the claim. The SDRF was received by the SF-DCT on May 16, 2005.
- 5. Ms. has an approaching cure deadline of June 14, 2005. The request for re-review is pending; no response has been received to date.
- 6. We understand that appeals to Judge Andrews from decisions of the prior Claims Administrator, Wendy Trachte-Huber, may be re-reviewed by the new Claims Administrator, David Austern, before they are reviewed by Judge Andrews. We also understand that there may be a backlog of appeals due to the recent transition in the Claims Administrator position. It appears that Ms. will not receive a decision on her request for re-review prior to her upcoming cure deadline.
- 7. In addition, we believe that the SF-DCT has been overly harsh in their evaluation of all disease claims in general and of Ms. 's claim in particular. We understand that there is an audit underway to determine whether the SF-DCT has been properly applying the Plan criteria in their review of disease claims. There are also several motions pending asking that the SF-DCT disclose all

substantive, non-published criteria that they are applying in their review of disease claims.

WHEREFORE, Ms. respectfully requests that this Court direct that her disease claim cure deadline be tolled until she is able to complete the re-review process, until the audit is completed to determine whether the SF-DCT has applying the proper criteria in reviewing disease claims, and until all substantive, non-published criteria are made publicly available to all claimants by the SF-DCT.
